School Responsibility

- Provide full information about the curriculum, each child's progress and standards achieved
- Invite parents to special assemblies and performances
- Provide reading books and set appropriate tasks for home learning

Home Responsibility

I will :

- Support my child by coming to parents' meetings with their teacher and being available to talk about my child's work
- Encourage my child to do any homework and other tasks set by the teacher
- Let the school know about any problems that might affect my child's work, behaviour or attendance and punctuality

BEHAVIOUR AND WELFARE

School Responsibility

- Look after your child's safety and happiness while in the care of the school
