5. Play it all the way through!

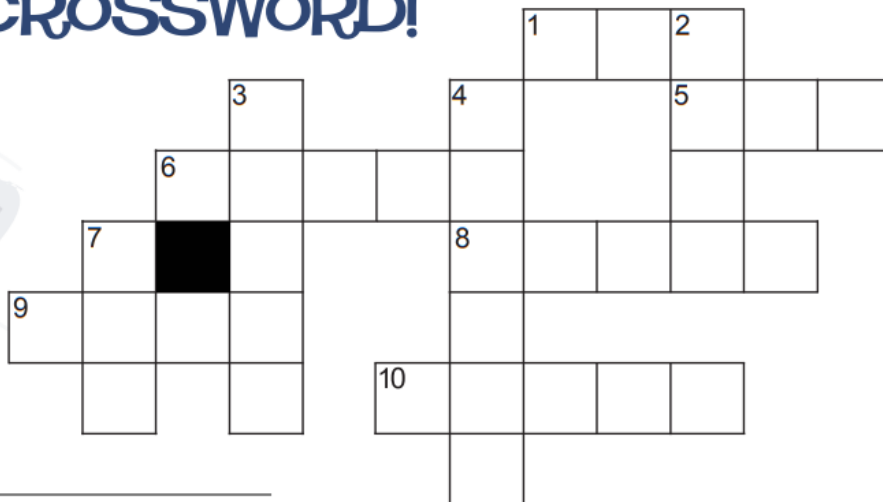
