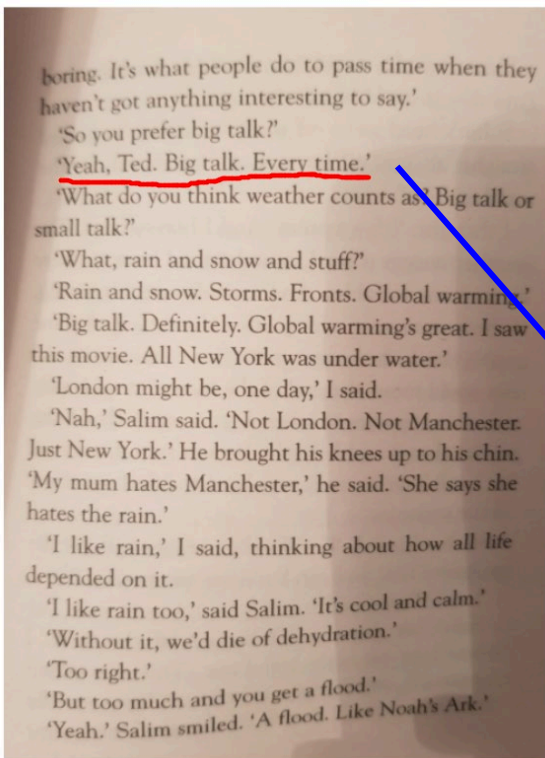
Using your copy of the book *The London Eye Mystery* create a character description about Ted and Kat's cousin Salim (ch.5)
