

Location		In the Andes mountain range in Chile, South America.		
Features		2,236 metres in height. Linked to another volcano. Dormant- only erupts occasionally.		
Eruptions		Erupted in 2011, for the first time in 50 years. Thousands of people were evacuated from their homes, and smoke travelled over 6 miles from the crater.
