$\mathbf{P}$ : Harry Potter is not fond of Malfoy.
E: I know this because the text says, 'He held out his hand to shake Harry's but Harry didn't shake it.'

E: This refusal suggests that Harry is not interested in being friends with Malfoy.

2) Ron has mixed feelings about going to Hogwarts. Agree? Disagree? Use evidence from the text to support your answer.
3) Ron finds Hermione annoying. Agree? Disagree? Use evidence from the text to support your answer.

5) What are your first impressions of Hogwarts?
