13 May 1940

Dear Diary,

Earlier this morning I remembered something from the years of war. It was a long time ago now, back when I was a boy working as a navy cadet.

During the time that war had been declared on Germany, I remember working on board with some of the other lads. We would usually be silly and mess around when suddenly, one night our ship was attacked. I remember waking up to find that seven armed ships surrounded us. From that moment onwards, things changed rapidly.
