## The key features of a powerful speech

The acronym **A FOREST** is one easy way to remember some of the key features of a powerful speech. It stands for:

- A alliteration
- **F** facts
- O opinion
- R rhetorical questions (questions without an answer)
- E emotive language (words which describe or inspire feelings)
- **S** statistics (key amounts, measurements or figures)
- T triples (repeating your point three times, but in different ways)
