## Lionesses Through To World Cup Semis!

Following a 3-0 victory over Norway, England's Lionesses are through to the world cup semi-finals.

In a post-match interview, manager Phil Neville asserted that it was an important victory and that he was confident they could continue their success in the competition.

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\_\_\_\_\_. In the second half, Lucy Bronze scored a spectacular goal bringing the score to 3-0 in favour of the Lionesses.

Responding to the result, the tournament's joint top goal scorer, Ellen White said, 'It's an amazing result and I'm so happy that I scored, the whole team was on fire tonight!' The game was watched by 7.6 million people, the biggest ever for a women's football match.
