No Tracksuit tops

If children are wearing a second layer over their t-shirts it must be a Canonbury sweat-shirt, fleece or cardigan, not a hoody or tracksuit top.

No Tracksuit Bottoms Yrs 1-6

Tracksuit bottoms are only permitted for PE for years 1-6, or as uniform for Nursery and Reception children.

Baseball caps are not allowed.
