- ¿Qué deportes haces? What sport do you like to do?
- ¿Juegas al rugby? Do you play rugby?

To tell someone what you like to play you can say:

• Juego al hockey - I play hockey.

Or to tell someone about your brother you can say:

Mi hermano juega al fútbol - My brother plays football.

The verb jugar is typically used for sports played with a ball.

Here are examples of how to tell people what you do:

- Todos los domingos juego al fútbol Every Sunday I play football.
- A menudo, después del colegio, juego a los videojuegos Often, after school, I play videogames.
- Siempre toco la guitarra con mis amigos I always play the guitar with my friends.
- De vez en cuando voy al centro comercial From time to time I go to

the shopping centre.

Turn on the captions to see what they are saying.

Task: Write 5 sentences describing what do you like doing (use the PDF sheet to help you). Or record yourself talking about your hobbies or ask someone what they do in Spanish use the PDF sheet to help you.
