

## Year 1 Topic Flight Week beginning 8<sup>th</sup> June 2020 Lesson

LO: To be able to predict, design and test an experiment using a range of material types and sizes.

## Can we make our own nest?

This week you are going to have a go at building your own bird's nest! If you can't do this, you could make a nest in your house out of bedding and blankets.





- Place sheets of newspaper on a table. Lay out all your nesting materials.
- Begin by making a framework for the nest. Weave twigs together to make a bowl shape.



- Use moss, dry grass, leaves, feathers and pieces of paper or card to pad out the inside of the nest.
- 5. If you wish, make some mud by mixing soil and water.
  Smear the mud onto the nest. When the mud dries, it will act like glue to hold the other nest materials together.
- 6. Wash your hands with warm water and soap after making your nest.

Ask an adult to help you place the nest in a tree or bush outdoors – just like a real bird's nest!
