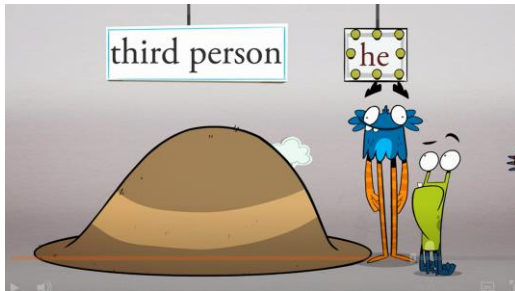


Main Activity

The boy/he goes to **I**

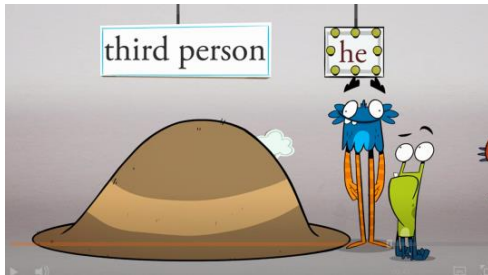
His goes to **my**
