

We can sort them by colour, size, shape and words.




# Let's put these coins in order. Smallest to greatest value

We are first of all going to look at the numbers on the coins to put them in order from smallest to greatest value. Can you find the coin with the smallest number?








We are going to compare the coins using greater than and less than.
