They eat small fish, like minnows or sticklebacks. They also eat tadpoles.

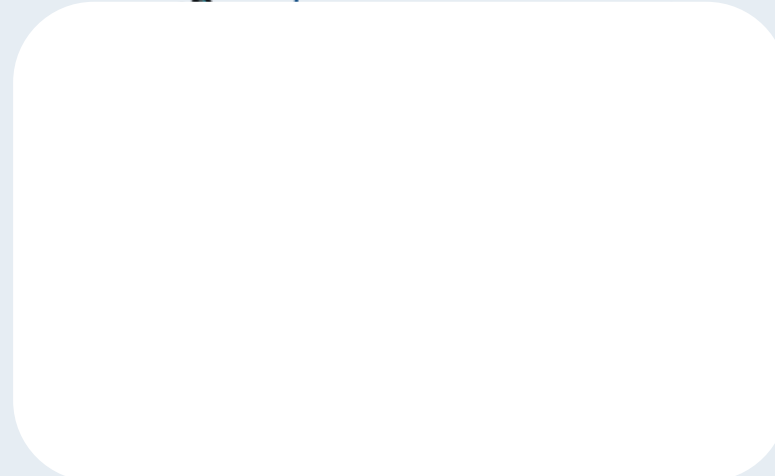


very bright blue and orange feathers


Main Activity: Now use the picture to write your own labels for the Green Woodpecker
