When the time is quarter past, the long minute hand always points to 3.

The shorter hour hand points just past the hour showing what time it is.

For example: The minute hand is at 3 and the hour hand is just past 7 so; It is quarter past 7 .

The shorter hour hand points to just before the hour showing what time it is.

For example: The minute hand is at 9 and the hour hand is just before 2 so; It is quarter to 2.
