




Success Criteria:

Challenge: Write a full sentence to describe how the crocodile is feeling.







Skill: Inference



Success Criteria:

- 1. Read the extracts.
- 2. Make inferences about how the crocodile is feeling on each page, giving reasons for why you think that
- 3. Read your work back to check they make sense.

Remember, inferences <u>must</u> have reasons. Your reasons should be based on clues from what you have read or what you have seen in the book.

EG: "I infer the crocodile is tired on page 6."

This has <u>not given enough detail</u> as I haven't said <u>why</u> I think what I think.

Remember to give reasons such as...

I think the crocodile is feeling tired on page 6 <u>because the author says</u> he is 'nodding off' which means he is falling asleep.

or

I can see from the illustration that the crocodile is yawning so I infer he must be feeling tired.

or

I infer the crocodile is feeling tired <u>because he has been very busy</u> eating all of the words and pages from the book.
