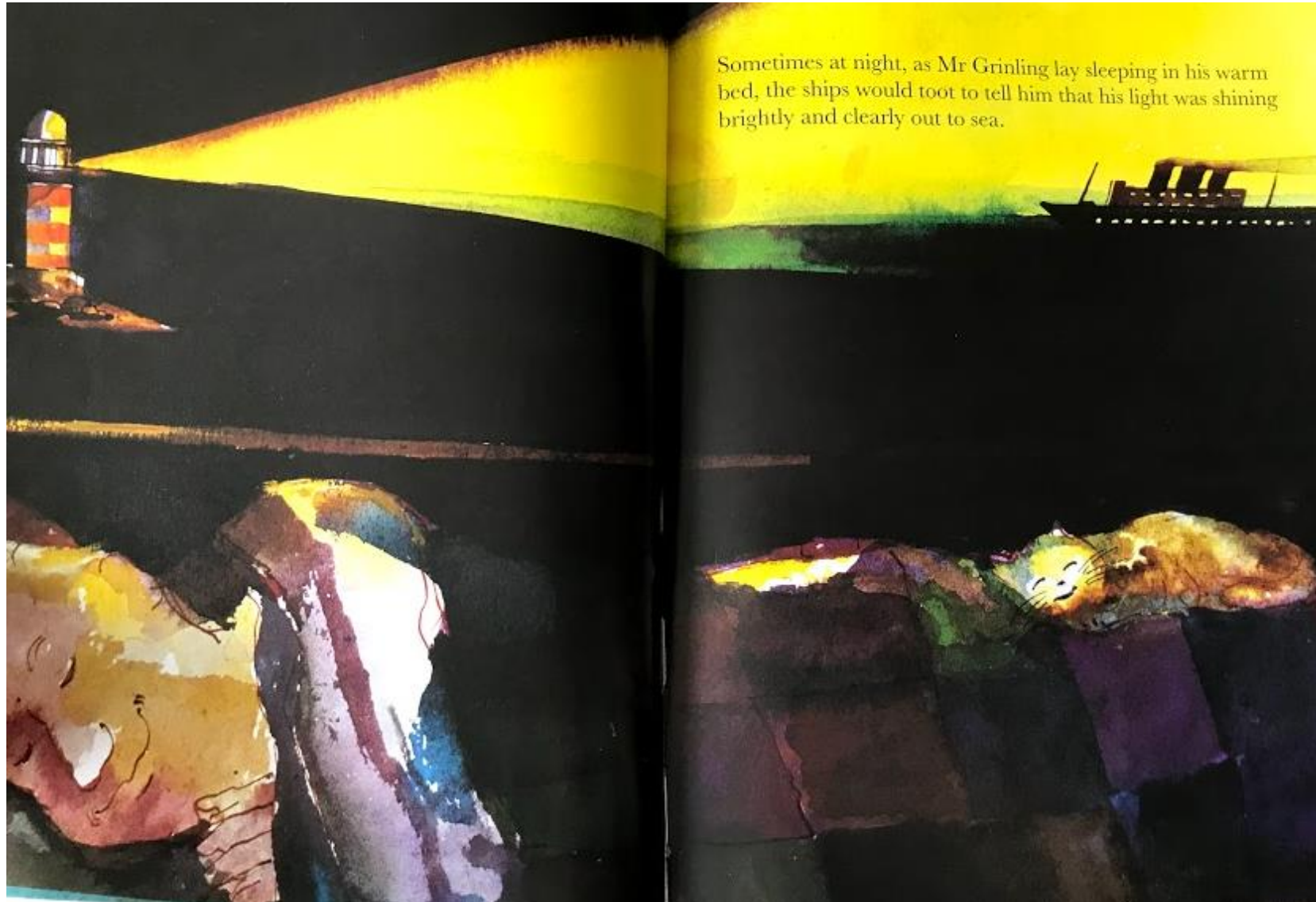


## Happy Thursday Athena and Odysseus!

Here is today's extract from the text to read:

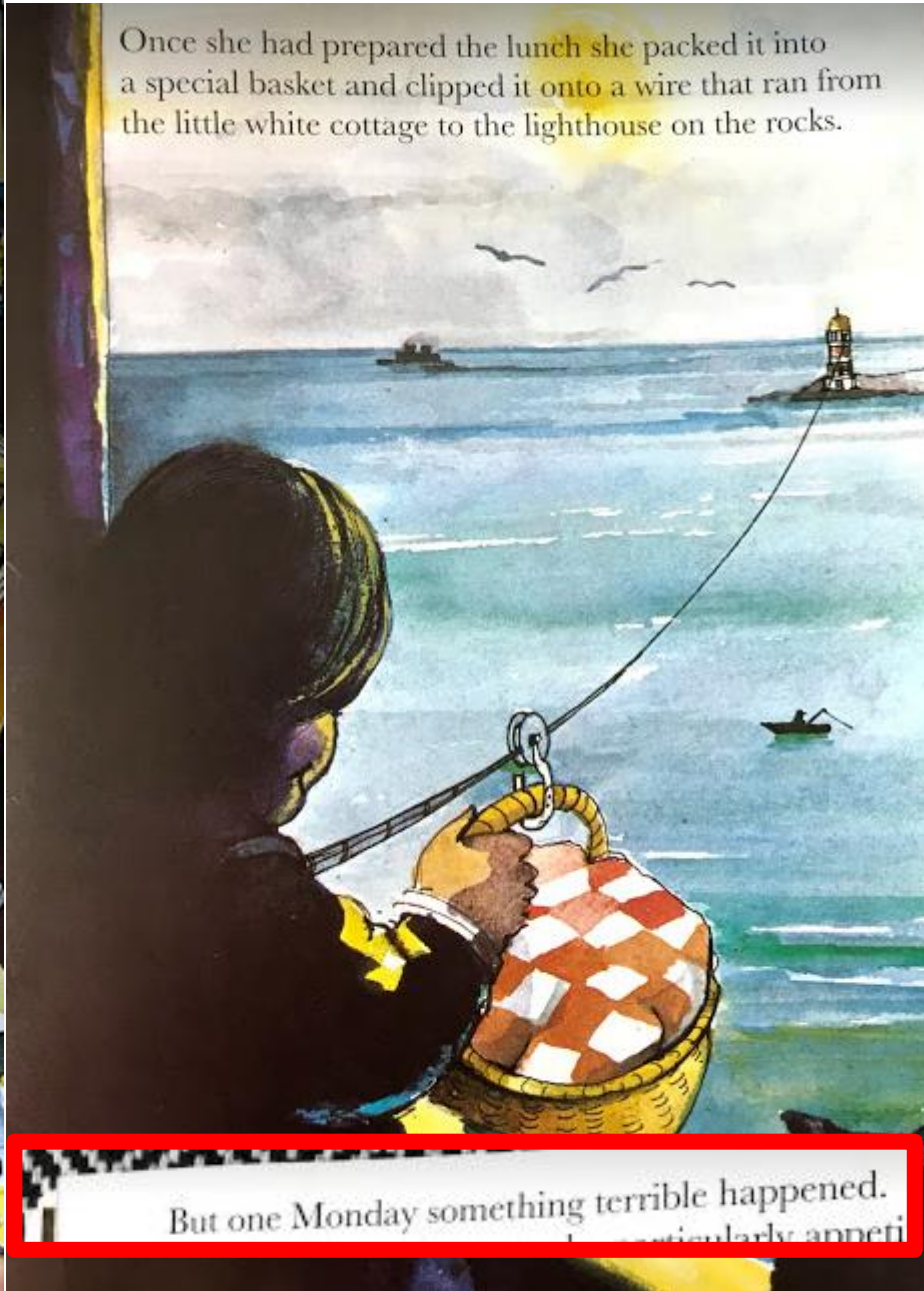


Sometimes at night, as Mr Grinling lay sleeping in his warm bed, the ships would toot to tell him that his light was shining brightly and clearly out to sea.

**I am concocting a delicious, fresh, colourful fruit salad.**

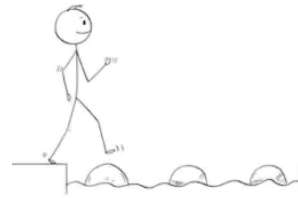
**The fruit salad I have made looks very appetising, it's making my mouth water!**
