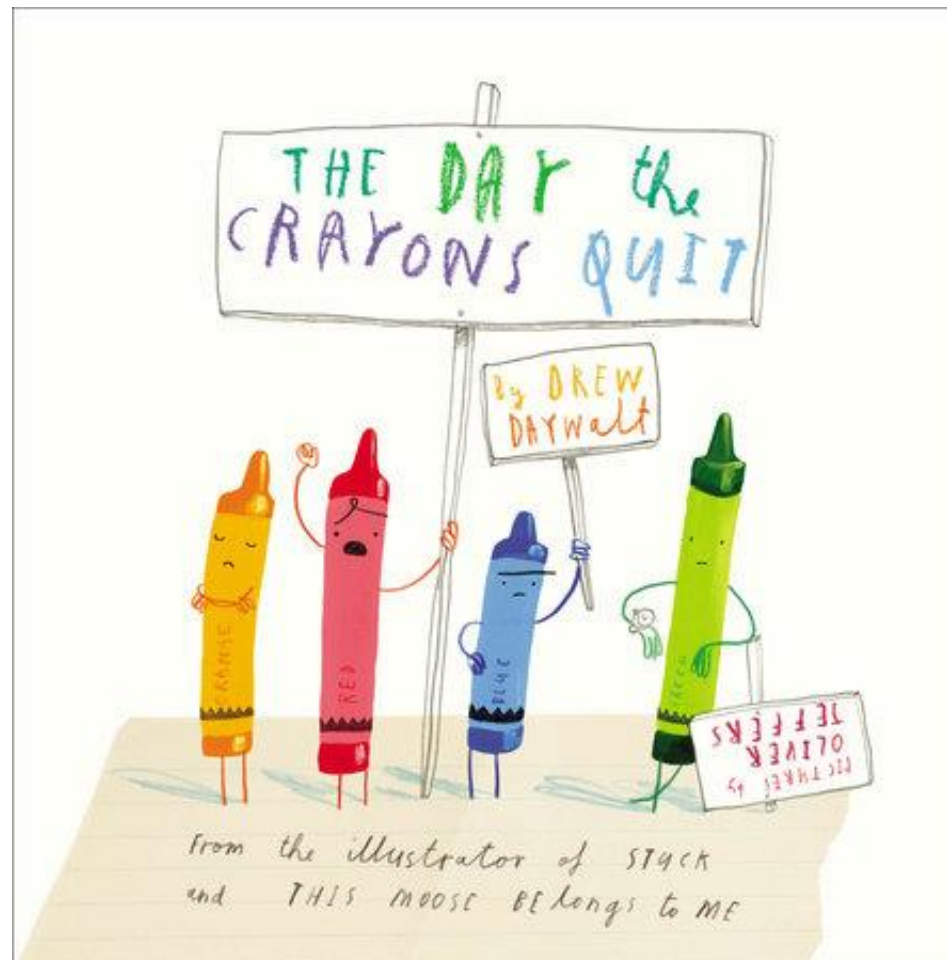


Welcome back Athena and Odysseus!

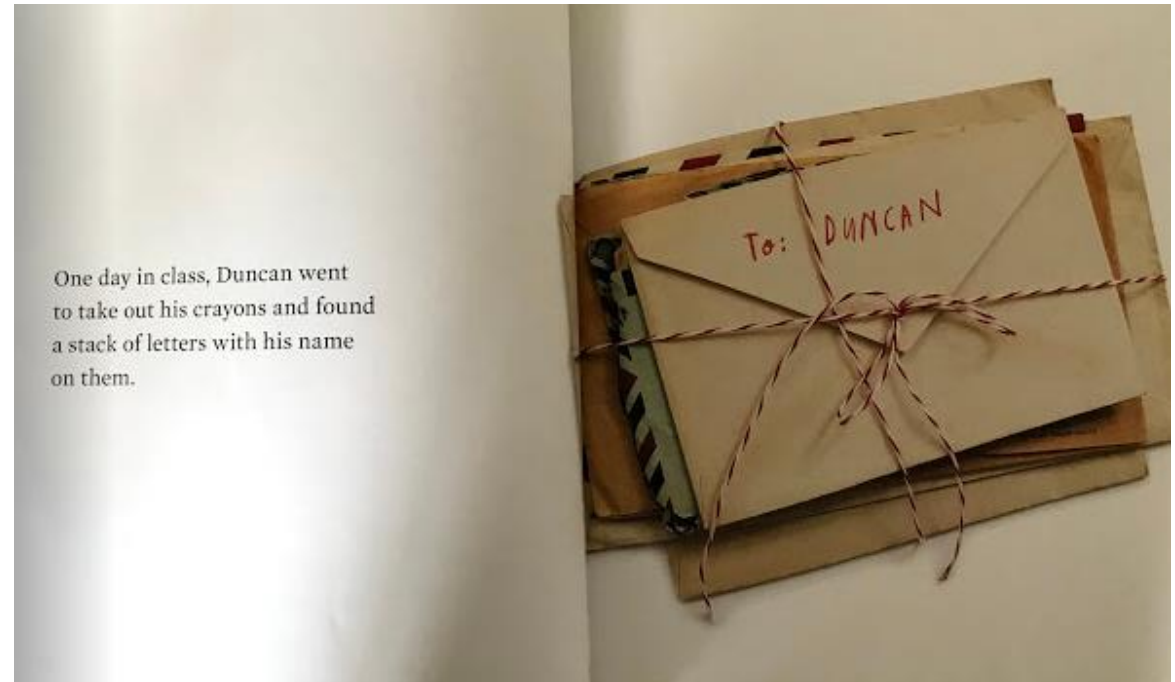
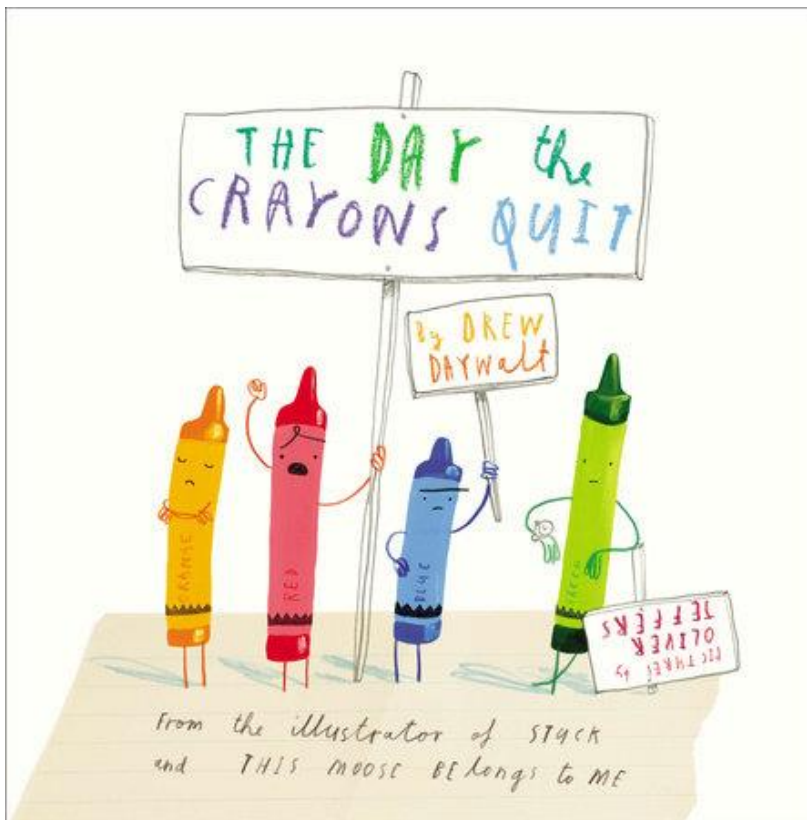
