Success Criteria:

1. Read Purple's letter below.
2. Write down or highlight with a coloured pencil all of the sentences that give clues about what Purple is like as a character.
3. Create a character description for Purple Crayon, making sure you describe what his **personality** is like, based on what you have read.

EG: Purple Crayon thinks very highly of himself because he calls his colour 'gorgeous'. In the letter he calls himself 'Your very neat friend' which might mean he likes things to look perfect and he takes his time when working or colouring. 'I'm going to completely lose it' might mean that he has a short temper, becomes angry easily or that he has had enough... etc.
