

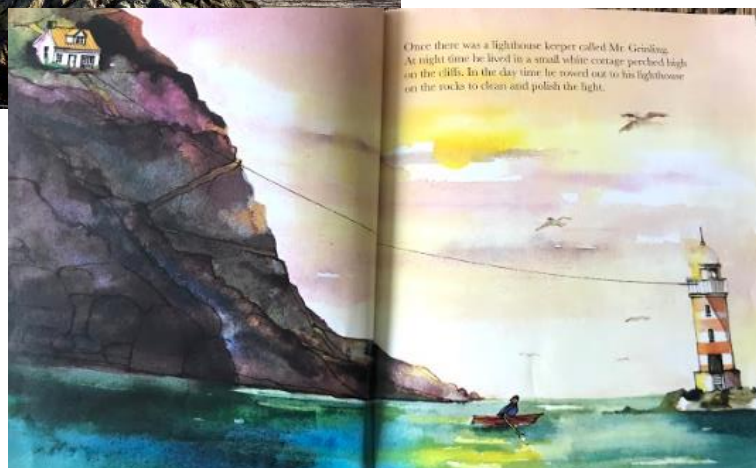
Happy Monday Athena and Odysseus!
