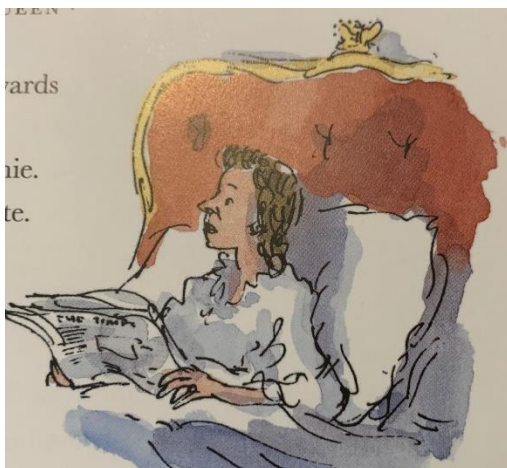


Task:

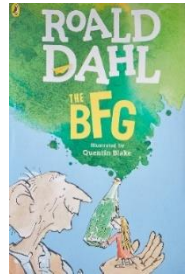
