# The Second World War

The Second World War was fought by countries on two different sides, the Allies and the Axis Powers. Here are some of the countries on each side.

| The Allies                  | The Axis Powers |

| Great Britain               | Germany         |
| The Soviet Union            | Italy           |
| France                      | Japan           |
| he United States of America | Romania         |
| India                       | Hungary         |
| China                       | Bulgaria        |

| Canada                      |                 |

Some countries were <u>neutral</u>, including Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and the Republic of Ireland.

Allies – those 'allied' to Britain. (On Britain's side)

Axis powers – those allied to Germany. (On Germany's side)

There were many other countries involved in the war as well.
