

Coming to School on 8th March Year 2

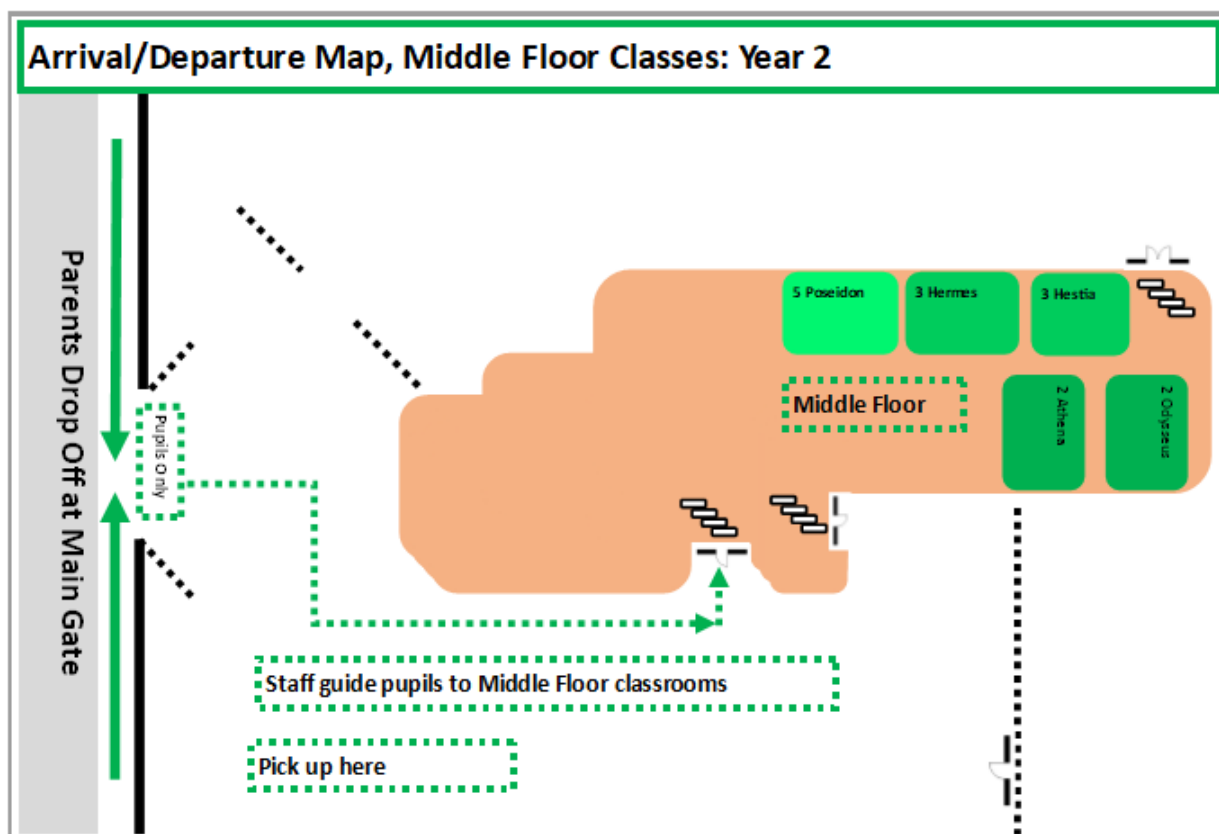
Start and End Times

Children return to school on 8th March. There are new arrival/departure arrangements and they are the same for both Year 2 classes.

**You can request to pick up siblings together – this would mean older siblings leaving early at the youngest child's time.*

- Parents and carers must wear face masks unless exempt
- You should leave straight away after drop-off and pick up without gathering
- There is no entry beyond the forecourt except in exceptional circumstances agreed in advance.





What to wear

Children should wear uniform 'as much as possible'. Please aim for your child to have a school top on every day. We encourage you to send your child in clean clothes every day as much as possible and understand that with increased washing, some uniform may not always be ready to wear.

No PE Kit

Children will not use PE Kit during PE and Sports lessons – please ensure that the bottom half of your child's uniform is suitable for daily physical activity, for example navy track-suit bottoms/ appropriate skirt/ black trainers.

School Virus Controls

Safety measures and routines are the same as in the Autumn Term, in line with government guidance:

- Children in year group 'bubbles' and staying with their own class most of the time
- 'Hands Face Space Replace' and 'Catch it Bin it Kill it' routines
- Staggered playtimes and lunchtimes
- Reduced movement around the school
- Class routines and timetables to ensure bubbles are kept apart as much as possible
- Social distancing between adults as much as possible
- Increased cleaning of high touch areas throughout day

Sickness

Parents should always keep their child at home if they are unwell.

Please be extra cautious and keep your child at home if you think they 'could be coming down with something' or 'they are not themselves today'. We will be taking extra caution and will not be using a 'wait and see' approach – if we judge that your child is presenting as ill we will contact you for collection.

Whole School Arrival and Departure Times from 8th March
