

## Children's Occupational Therapy Drop in Clinic









If you require advice from an occupational therapist, you can receive support via our occupational therapy drop-in clinic.

#### What is it?

- A 20 minute virtual or telephone appointment.
- A one-off appointment and no open referral is required. There is no limit to how often you
  would like to attend.
- An opportunity to speak to an occupational therapist (OT) about any concerns you may have regarding your child's development and needs.
- A way to get some ideas and advice on how to help your child to learn new functional skills (e.g. dressing skills, scissor skills, handwriting, cutlery skills etc...)
