On Friday 27th May, everyone at Canonbury Primary School will vote for one of the following class name themes:

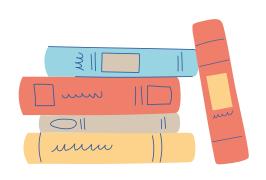


- -Trees
