Why are National Education Union members on strike next week?

We all want the best education for our children, with personal support and extra help when they need it. To do this we need to grow and keep more teachers - the NEU is concerned that schools will find this hard to achieve when teachers' pay has been going down over time, with the result that:

- 1 in 3 teachers leaves the profession within 5 years
- Last year, a third fewer trainees began teacher training than are needed
- Experienced teachers have seen a real term drop in salary of 13% since 2010 (source: Institute for Fiscal Studies)
- This year, schools had to fund pay rises below inflation from their own budgets, leaving less money to employ the amount of staff needed

NEU members don't want to disrupt children's education - they are campaigning because they want all schools to have the great teachers and resources they need to provide excellent education and care to every child, now and in the future.

Child Flu Vaccination

Children are at risk of suffering from flu, and the flu virus spreads easily especially amongst younger children in enclosed spaces like the classroom. For children with existing health conditions there is a higher risk of serious illness that could lead to hospitalisation.

As temperatures fall again in the coming weeks, getting vaccinated against flu gives your child that vital extra protection from this dangerous virus which spreads more easily in colder weather when we spend more time with friends and family indoors.

All primary school children (from Reception year up to Year 6) are eligible for a free flu nasal spray. The nasal spray is quick and painless, and most children will be able to get it at their school. If you have missed your child's school vaccination, it's not too late – you can still get a flu vaccine from your GP if your child has a long term health condition and is in the 'at risk' category or your local School Aged Immunisation Service as per the details below.

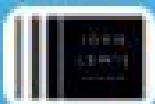
