



Easter Extravaganza





To apply to the fund for a one off payment of £250 YOU MUST

- live in Islington
- pay rent
- · be in employment
- less than £50,000 gross household earnings
- Combined household of savings of less than £5,000

PROVIDE PROOF OF

- rent tenancy agreement of letter from landlord
- · savings- recent bank statements for every household member
- · earnings recent payslip for every household member

Our Family Information Service (FIS) can help with:

- Free early education for 2, 3 and 4 year olds
- Childcare for under 5s, including childminders and Islington's funded nurseries, and childcare for over 5s - after-school and holidays
- 30 hours free childcare
- Tax-fee childcare
- Childcare through Universal Credit
- Islington Childcare Bursary

Apply for a Childcare Bursary

If you live in Islington, are claiming benefits and have a child aged 0-16 (or up to 18 with disabilities) who needs childcare, you may be entitled to a Childcare Bursary. The bursary is there to help parents who are starting work, a work placement, or short-term training to pay for childcare. It does not need to be paid back.
