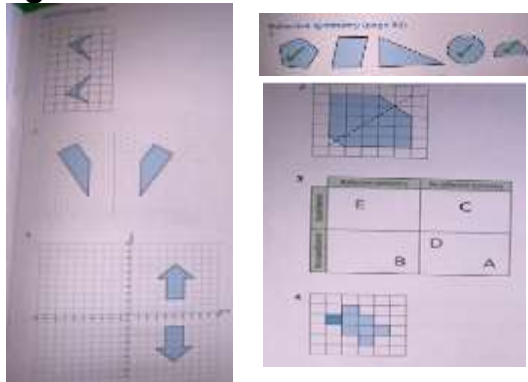


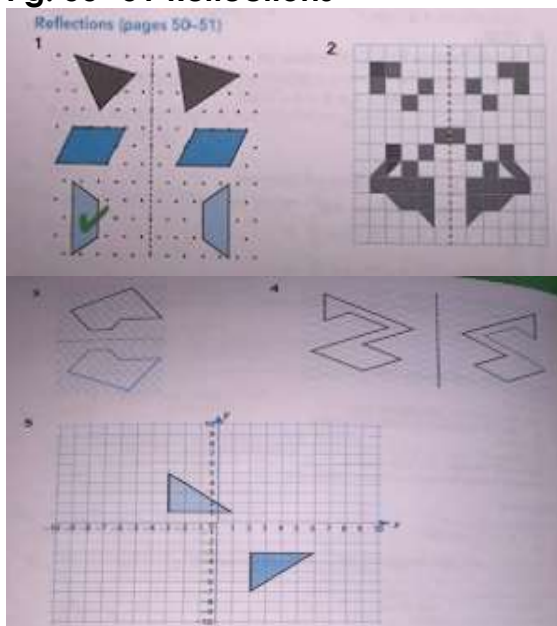

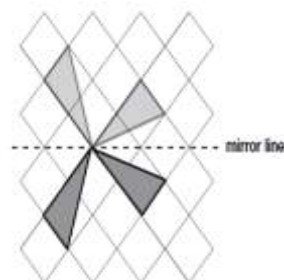

Task 1

Diagram completed as shown:



Accept slight inaccuracies in drawing.
Diagram need not be shaded.

Task 3

$y = -x$

Do not accept $y = x -$

There is no mark for drawing in the mirror line (this is an earlier level concept).

Task 2

Diagram completed correctly as shown:



OR



Accept alternative unambiguous indications, e.g. squares shaded, ticked or crossed.
