Volcanoes of the World!

Mount Fuji, Japan

Located on the Island of Honhsu, this volcano last erupted in 1707. Standing at 3,776 meters tall, Mount Fuji has been dormant since it last erupted but is considered an **active volcano**.



Mount Etna, Italy

Described as one of the world's most active volcanoes, Mount Etna is situated on the island of Sicily. Towering at 3,326 metres, this volcano last erupted on Christmas eve in 2018.

Kilauea, Hawaii

With slow moving lava flow, Kilauea is a shield volcano in the U.S. state of Hawaii. It is over 4000 metres tall and last erupted for over 3 months in 2018, destroying 657 houses.
