

Year 2 Curriculum Information Autumn 2024







History and Geography

Our Topics this half term are London Landmarks and The Great Fire of London.

We will be looking at significant London landmarks and then going back in time to learn about how and when the Fire happened. We will using sources such as the diary of Samuel Pepys.





English

For our first text this term, we will be sharing Katie's adventures in 'Katie in London' by James Mayhew.

Later in the term we will read 'Toby and The Great Fire of London'. This is a story based in the time of the Great Fire of London.

We will also look at nonfiction texts and write our own non-fiction text about the Fire.



Maths

This term we will be focusing on the following areas:

- Number: Place value
- Number: Addition and subtraction
- **Measurement:** Money
- Number: Multiplication and division

We will develop our understanding of new mathematical skills using the concrete, pictorial and abstract approach.



Science

In our topic on **Plants** we will observe, identify and classify different plants. We will also be planting seeds and bulbs.

Whilst studying Animals Including Humans, we will find out about the basic needs for survival (water, food and air). We will also learn about the importance of exercise, a healthy diet, and hygiene.

Physical Education

Multi-skills: Our sports coaches from Team Kick Start will deliver lessons outside using an integrated approach, where children learn to coordinate a wide range of fundamental movement skills in various sports activities within each lesson.

Music

In preparation for our visit to the London Symphony Orchestra in December, we will be composing our own pieces of music and developing the skills of listening, pulse, rhythm and pitch.
