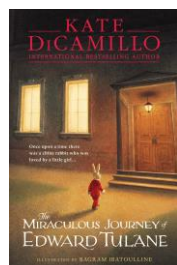
### Summer Term 2025

## English

We will begin the term reading the book **The Miraculous journey of Edward Tulane** and producing an adventure story about the journey of a missing toy.

We will then be studying 'Cool' by Michael Morpurgo.

We will continue to consolidate our Year 4 writing features to ensure that children are ready for Year 5.



## Maths



This term we will be covering:

- **Decimals** tenths, hundredths and thousands
- **Number:** Money – using decimal notation and solving problems.
- **Time** – analogue, digital and 24 hour time
- **Shape:** Properties of shapes, angles, and symmetry.
- **Position and direction** – Translating shapes and writing coordinates.

Throughout all our units there will be opportunities for problem solving and investigations.

## Science



In our topic on **Living Things and their habitats** we will be exploring the seven life processes and how to classify living creatures.

We will be learning about the characteristics of living things and looking at how to group and classify animals and plants. We will also be looking at environmental changes and how these impact a range of habitats.

## Physical Education

Our sports coaches from Team Kick Start will deliver lessons outside using an integrated approach

Teacher led PE this term will be striking and fielding games.

We will continue our recorder lessons every **Wednesday** afternoon.

## Computing

Children will:

- Create multiple simple scenes dialogue using 'Scratch'. They will learn to write programs and understand how to 'de-bug' and find mistakes.
- Continue to learn how to stay safe on-line.

## Art

- Exploring decorative techniques to produce a tie dye t-shirt.
- Exploring and creating their own Ancient Egyptian amulets

## Design & Technology

Linked to our Sustainable Fashion project. Children will be evaluating a range of products and upcycling old clothes into usable fashion accessories. Children will be practising sewing skills and using them in their final outcomes.

## Religious Studies



Question: **What is it like to be a Hindu in Britain today?**

- Children will learn about the beliefs, practices and daily routines of a Hindu living in Britain.
- We will look at how Hindu's worship at home and in a Mandir and make comparisons between our lives and the teachings of other religions.

## PSHE



**Relationship and Sex Education:**

Children will learn about:

- The way we grow and change throughout the human lifecycle
- About the physical changes associated with puberty.
- About menstruation and wet dreams.
- About the impact of puberty in physical hygiene and strategies for managing this
- How puberty affects emotions and behaviour and strategies for dealing with this.
