FASHION – TASK 3

Hello Year 4,

This is your third task for our fashion topic. You will be exploring fashion around the world and answering questions.

You will look at some traditional clothing worn across the world. Traditional means that it has been worn for many years. It is important to remember that not all people wear these clothes all the time - most people around the world also wear jeans, trainers, t-shirts just like you!

LO: To develop knowledge about the diversity of people around the world

This is a GEOGRAPHY task.



BIG QUESTION:

Can you find out about a style of dress worn somewhere else in the world and answer questions about it?

Vocabulary: sari, Massai, Shuka, animal hide, Sámi, gákti, kolt, tunic, conical, non la, kimono, Chola, Cholita, sombrero, pollera, Arctic, Inuit, caribou,

1. Discuss:

What are some of the roles of clothing in general?

Why do people in different countries wear different clothes?

2. Observe:

On the following pages are some examples of clothing from around the world. Look at what these people are wearing and think about why.

3. Research:

Choose one of the traditional dresses in the pictures or one from another country that you are interested in.

Carry out some research to answer these questions:

- Where is this country?
- What is their traditional dress?
- Who wears it?
- When is it worn?
- How is it worn?
- Why is it designed this way?

4. Present:

Create a fact file which includes:

- either a drawing or a photo or your chosen traditional dress
- information you have discovered through your research.

You can do this either on paper or on a computer.

Success Criteria:

1. Write a title

2. Include a drawing or photo

3. Label the picture

4. Use subheadings to organize your information

5. Make it clear and easy to understand

6. Make it appealing to the eye e.g. with colour
