Vocabulary

motionless – still, unmoving

errand - a short journey in order to deliver or collect something

weather-vane - a revolving pointer to show the direction of the wind, usually on top of a building



objectionable – unpleasant, offensive

meekly – quietly, gently

gum drop – a jellied sweet sometimes coated in sugar

near-sighted – short sighted – can't see well in the distance

blundered into – moved clumsily or carelessly into something

detested - hated

inheritance - a physical or mental characteristic inherited from your parents

Charlotte is a common **orb-weaver spider**, commonly known as a **barn spider**.

Using information that we learn about Charlotte in Chapter 5, create a fact file about **barn spiders**.

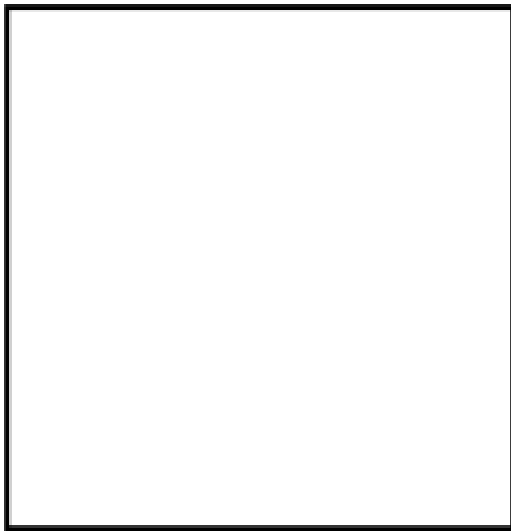
