Curriculum Overview

Summer Term 2024

English



The term begins with 'Writing through Art' an exciting project linked to paintings at Kenwood House and culminating with an amazing trip to see the pictures studied at first hand.

We will then be studying 'Cool' by Michael Morpurgo.

We will continue to consolidate our Year 4 writing features to ensure that children are ready for Year 5.

Maths



This term we will be covering:

- Decimals tenths, hundredths and thousands
- Number: Money using decimal notation and solving problems.
- Time analogue, digital and 24 hour time
- **Shape:** Properties of shapes, angles, and symmetry.
- Position and direction Translating shapes and writing coordinates.

Throughout all our units there will be opportunities for problem solving and investigations.

Science



In our topic on Living Things and their habitats we will be exploring the seven life processes and how to classify living creatures.

We will be learning about the characteristics of living things and looking at how to group and classify animals and plants. We will also be looking at environmental changes and how these impact a range of habitats.

Our sports coaches from Team Kick Start will deliver lessons outside using an integrated approach

Linked to our Sustainable Fashion project be will be evaluating a range of products and upcycling old clothes into usable fashion accessories.

Computing

Children will:

- Create simple programs using 'Scratch' on Purple Mash. They will learn to write programs and understand how to 'de-bug' and find mistakes.
- Blogging to share ideas linked to our 'Writing through Art' project.
- Continue to learn how to stay safe on-line.

Religious Studies



Question: What is it like to be a Hindu in Britain today?

- -Children will learn about the beliefs, practices and daily routines of a Hindu living in Britain.
- -We will look at how Hindu's worship at home and in a Mandir and make comparisons between our lives and the teachings of other religions.

PSHE



Relationship and Sex Education:

Children will learn about:

- The way we grow and change throughout the human lifecycle
- About the physical changes associated with puberty.
- About menstruation and wet dreams.
- About the impact of puberty in physical hygiene and strategies for managing this
- How puberty affects emotions and behaviour and strategies for dealing with this.
